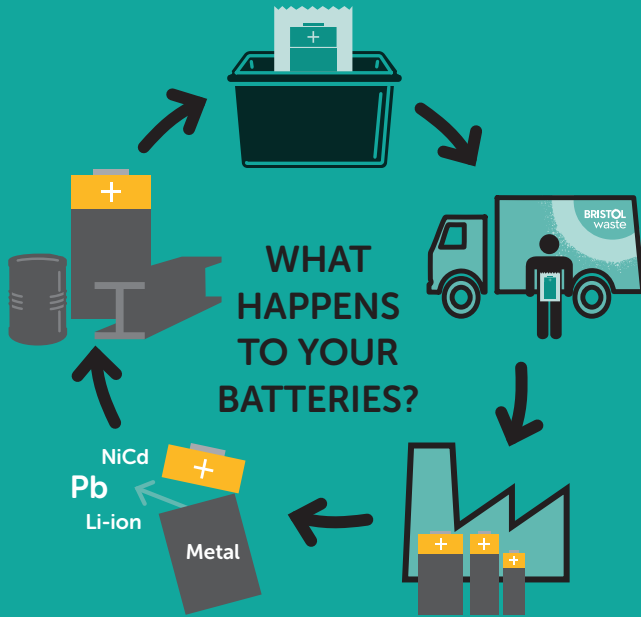

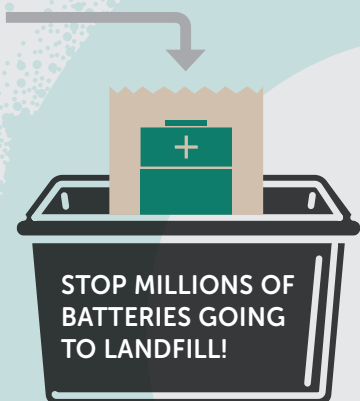
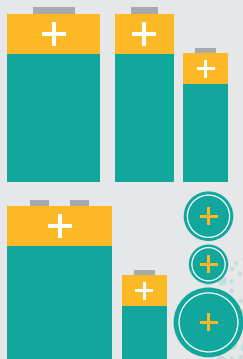

178 million used batteries are hoarded in UK homes. They contain heavy metals including lead, mercury, zinc and lithium – which can be potentially harmful to the environment, but the good news is they can all be recycled. Don't bin your batteries!

So we're giving you these handy bags to collect all your old batteries and recycle them.

WHAT BATTERIES CAN I RECYCLE?

You can recycle batteries of all shapes and sizes, including button and square batteries, and old rechargeable batteries.

You can also put large batteries such as laptop/ phone/power tool batteries in your black box, don't worry if they don't fit in the bag.
